- Participation in training workshops; Supportive Conversations & Youth Mental Health First Aid facilitated by professionals
- Provision of formal mentoring relationships established through linking mentees with mentors who have dealt with, overcome and succeeded in the struggles and challenges of growing up with short stature.
- Matching mentees to mentors, by interests (vocational or recreational), gender, education or career interest and location.
- Opportunity for vocational skill development, matching of mentees to mentors (emerging and established) in the arts and sports etc.
- Successful mentors will have opportunity to undertake "Train the Trainer" program to learn how to upskill new mentors.
